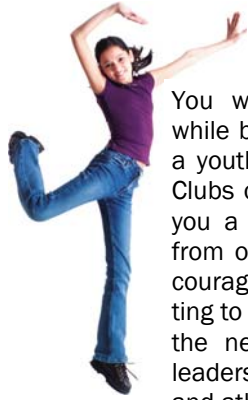

Our Mission

★ In 2010, BGC GC had approximately 2,800 registered members, a 10% increase from 2009.

★ Construction of the IP Center at North Bay was completed in June 2010. This new facility now serves over 300 youth from the D'Iberville and Biloxi area.

★ The Hancock County Unit moved to the newly renovated Valena C. Jones Center in September 2010. This 3000 square foot facility allows the Unit to serve over 300 youth. Construction on an adjacent Teen Center is scheduled to be completed in 2011.

★ The Forest Heights Center opened in September 2010, replacing the Club that was destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. This facility can serve over 300 youth in Gulfport.

★ Over 3,200 Education and Career Development sessions were run organization wide in 2010 and the current overall grade point average score for BGC GC members is 85.4 percent.

★ BGC GC served an additional 1500 youth through the New Hope Program, a school based therapeutic behavioral facilitation program.

★ Our youth completed over 1000 Community Service hours in 2010.

Through the thoughtful gestures and continued support from businesses and individuals, we will continue to reach youth and families across the coast and strengthen our momentum in results-oriented youth development.
